AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE REGULAR MEETING DATE AND PLACE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF HUNTER'S HOLLOW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

Be it Ordained by the City of Hunter's Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky:
