AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS HOLLOW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, GRANTING PERMISSION FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE FROM MATRIX-VISION OF BULLITT COUNTY, INC., TO FIRST CABLE-VISION, INC.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. V, adopted by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow (the "council") under which Ordinance Matrix-Vision of Bullitt County, Inc. (formerly named Bullitt County Communications, Inc.) ("Franchisee"), holds a cable television franchise ("the Franchise") from the City of Hunters Hollow (the "City"); and

WHEREAS, Franchisee wishes to transfer and assign its cable television system serving the City, and its franchise rights under the Franchise, to First Cable-Vision, Inc. ("First Cable-Vision"); and

WHEREAS, Franchisee may not transfer its franchise rights under the Franchise without the prior approval of the Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

Section I: The City Council hereby gives unto and grants its approval of the transfer and assignment of the cable television system serving the City and of the franchise rights under the Franchise from Franchisee to First Cable-Vision.

Section II: The Mayor and the City Clerk of the City are each hereby authorized and empowered to take such actions and execute such documents as may be requested by Franchisee or by Frist Cable-Vision to evidence the approval by the Council and the City to the transfer of the cable television system and of the franchise rights under the Franchise pursuant hereto.

Section III: In all other respects, the Franchise is and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not effect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section V: Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section VI: This Ordinance shall be published according to law.
