

ORDINANCE NO. XVIII

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES ON PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES AS OF JANUARY 1, 1985.

The City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: That an ad valorem tax of 0.16 cents on each \$100.00 of value of all property in said City, of Public Service Companies which are assessed by the Department of Revenue, is hereby levied for the year 1985 as of January 1, 1985.

SECTION TWO: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees, for the repair and maintenance of streets and public ways and public buildings in said City, to pay for lighting city streets, and to pay all proper charges and legal demands against the city.

SECTION THREE: The Clerk is directed to advertise this ordinance by publication as provided by law.

Given first reading at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 20 day of ~~July~~^{August}, 1985. Given second reading and passed at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 21 day of July, 1985.
