AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES ON PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES AS OF JANUARY 1, 1986.

SECTION I: That an ad valorem tax of $\frac{0.20}{0.20}$ on each \$100.00 of value of all property in said City, of public service companies which are assessed by the Department of Revenue, is hereby levied for the year 1986 as of January 1, 1986.
