## ORDINANCE NO. 985-30

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE REQUIRING ALL PERSONS, FIRMS OR CORPORATIONS TO CUT WEEDS AND BUSHES, AND FORBIDDING THE DUMPING OF TRASH, CANS, BOTTLES OR GARBAGE ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE STREETS, WAYS OR PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

Section I: It shall hereafter be the duty of all persons, firms, or corporations owning, leasing, or possessing properties or lands fronting on all streets, or public ways within the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, to cause all weeds and bushes growing upon such premises to within two hundred feet (200') of the center line of such street, alley or public way, except ornamental shrubs, farm crops, vegetables and trees, to be cut so as to permit no more than six inches (6") growth above the ground.

Section II: It shall hereinafter be unlawful to dump, throw or place any trash, cans, bottles or garbage of any kind upon the streets, alleys, ways or property, whether the same be public or private, within the city limits of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky.

Section III: Any person, firm or corporation violating any paragraph of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) and not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense; or in the alternative, after ten (10) days notice given by the City Clerk to the last mailing address of the property owner or renter, the City may obtain the services of an individual for the purpose of cleaning or mowing said property and may file a mechanic's lien in the office of the Clerk of the Bullitt County Court for the amount of funds so expended.

Section IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

Section V: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section VI: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not effect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Given first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 19th day of May, 1987. Given second reading and passed at a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 20th day of May, 1987.
