

ORDINANCE NO. 985-XXXV

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES AND PROVIDING ASSESSMENT, EQUALIZATION AND COLLECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH KRS 132.487.

The City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That an ad valorem tax of \$ .09 on each \$100.00 of value of all personal property taxable for municipal purposes, except property assessed by the State, in said City is hereby levied for the year 1987 as of January 1, 1987.

SECTION II: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees, for the repair and maintenance of streets and public ways and public buildings in said City, to pay for lighting City Streets, and to pay all proper charges and legal demands against the City.

SECTION III: That the assessment made by the Bullitt County Tax Commissioner for State and County purposes for 1987 shall be and is hereby adopted as the assessment for City purposes. These taxes shall be collected by the Bullitt County Court Clerk as provided for by KRS 132.487, et.seq.

SECTION IV: The City Clerk be and she is hereby directed to forward to the Department of Property Taxation, 592 East Main Street, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601, a 1987 motor vehicle property tax rate certification for the year 1987.

SECTION V: The Clerk is directed to advertise the above as provided by law.

SECTION VI: All payments of taxes provided for herein shall be received by the City Clerk/Treasurer at the business office of the City of Hunters Hollow, 11300 Angelina Road, Hunters Hollow, Kentucky 40229.

SECTION VII: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not effect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Given first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 18th day of August, 1987. Given second reading, voted upon and passed at a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 19th day of August, 1987.
