## ORDINANCE NO 985-38

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS HOLLOW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

 ${\tt BE\ IT\ ORDAINED}$  by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

## Section I: No Parking

At any time, it shall be unlawful to permit any vehicle or other personal property to stand in any place which has been duly signed and marked by the order of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow.

## Section II: Parking at Curb

No vehicle shall be parked with the left side of such vehicle next to the curb, except upon one-way streets, and it shall be unlawfull to stand or park any vehicle in a street other than parallel with the curb and with the two (2) right wheels of the vehicle within twelve inches (12") of the regularly established curb line. At any place a standing vehicle shall not reduce the useable width of the roadway from moving traffic to less than twelve feet (12').

Section III: It shall be unlawfull to park any vehicle upon any street for the purpose of displaying it for sale, or to park any vehicle upon any business street from which vehicle merchandise is peddled.

Section IV: The Chief of Police or any other person authorized by the Mayor and Council shall cause signs to be posted in all areas where parking is limited or prohibited, indicating such limitation or prohibition.

Section V: Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each offense.

Section VI: In addition to the above fine provision, the vehicle constituting the violation may be removed at the expense of the owner.

Section VII: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

Section VIII: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not effect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section IX: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
