## ORDINANCE NO. 985-41

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES ON PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES AS OF JANUARY 1, 1988.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION I: That an ad valorem tax of 19.8 on each \$100.00 of value of all property in said City, of public service companies, which are assessed by the Department of Revenue, is hereby levied for the year 1988 as of January 1, 1988.

SECTION II: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees, for repair and maintenance of streets and public ways and public buildings in said City, to pay for lighting city streets and to pay all proper charges and legal demands against the City.

SECTION III: Provisions of Ordinance No. 985-40 as to method of collection and enforcement shall apply to the tax levied therein.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION IV:}}$  Clerk is directed to advertise this Ordinance by publication as provided by law.

SECTION V: All payments of taxes provided for herein shall be received by the City Clerk/Treasurer at the business offices of the City of Hunters Hollow, 11300 Angelina Road, Louisville, Kentucky 40229.

SECTION VI: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION VII: Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Given first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky on the 16th day of August, 1988. Given second reading, voted upon and passed at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, the day of September, 1988.
