

ORDINANCE NO. 985-53

AN ORDINANCE SPECIFYING THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENT FOR STREET CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS HOLLOW.

The City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: The minimum requirements for roadway within the City of Hunters Hollow are as follows:

1. The base of said roadway must be four (4) inches of compacted dense grade aggregate.
2. Four Tenths (4/10) of one (1) gallon tack coat (per square yard) shall be applied between the base and the asphalt coat.
3. The asphalt on top of the base is to be one and one-half (1- $\frac{1}{2}$ ) inches of class I, surface mix.
4. All asphalt streets accepted by the city for perpetual maintenance must have a width from edge of asphalt to edge of asphalt of twenty (20) feet.


SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall become effective September 1, 1990 and all streets submitted for perpetual maintenance to the City after that date must meet the above specifications.

SECTION THREE: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are repealed.

SECTION FOUR: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
