ORDINANCE NO. 985-70

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF HUNTERS HOLLOW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1993, THOUGH JUNE 30, 1994, BY ESTIMATING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE OPERATION OF CITY GOVENMENT.
