ORDINANCE NO. 985-75

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES ON PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES AS OF JANUARY 1, 1993.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION TWO: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees; for the repair and maintenance of streets, public ways, and public buildings in said city; to pay for lighting city streets; and to pay all proper charges and legal demands against the City.

SECTION THREE: The provisions of Ordinance No. 985-73 as to the method of collection and enforcement shall apply to the tax levied herein.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION FOUR:}}$ The Clerk is directed to advertise this Ordinance as provided by law.

SECTION FIVE: All payments of taxes provided for herein shall be made to the City Clerk/Treasurer at the business office of the City of Hunters Hollow, 11300 Angelina Road, Louisville, Bullitt County, Kentucky 40229.

SECTION SIX: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance.

SECTION SEVEN: Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
