

ORDINANCE NO. 985-148

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2004, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2005.

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of June, 2004, the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow did adopt Ordinance No. 985-141 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CITY OF HUNTERS HOLLOW, KENTUCKY, ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2004, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2005, and,
