## **ORDINANCE NO. 985-155**

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE REGULAR MEETING DATE AND PLACE OF CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS HOLLOW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky had previously by Ordinance established 1251 Hillview Blvd., Louisville, Kentucky as the regular meeting site for City Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received notice that this facility will no longer be available for the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, and

WHEREAS, this dislocation of the operation of City government has resulted in inconvenience to the City, City Council, and general public resulting in an emergency situation, and

WHEREAS, Kentucky State Statutes require the location of regular City Council meetings to be established by ordinance to adequately inform the general public of the correct site where the public's business is performed, and

WHEREAS, the lack of a designated site for the holding of the regular City Council meetings has resulted in the meetings of the City Council being classified as Special Meetings which limit the issues which can be discussed and the public input which can be received, now, therefore:

The City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain as follows:

<u>SECTION ONE:</u> The regular meeting date, time and location of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, shall be on the third Tuesday night of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the Jewish Hospital, Doctors Office Building, Community Development Room, 1903 W. Hebron Lane, Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky.

<u>SECTION TWO:</u> This Ordinance shall become effective upon first reading, approval, and publication, as an emergency condition has been declared to exist as set forth herein pursuant to KRS 83A.060(7).

<u>SECTION THREE:</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are repealed.

<u>SECTION FOUR:</u> Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
