

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-01

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS HOLLOW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS HOLLOW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION ONE: No Parking Places: At any time, it shall be unlawful to permit any vehicle to stand in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a policeman or traffic control device:

- a) In any intersection.
- b) In a crosswalk.
- c) Within thirty (30) feet of a traffic signal, beacon, or sign on the approaching side.
- d) Within twenty (20) feet of any intersection or crosswalk.
- e) At any place where the standing of a vehicle will reduce the usable width of the roadway for moving traffic to less than fifteen (15) feet.
- f) Within ten (10) feet of a fire hydrant.
- g) At any place where the vehicle would block the use of a driveway.
- h) At any place where official signs prohibit parking.
- i) At any place where the vehicle would block a mailbox.
- j) On any city easement adjoining the street (i.e. between the sidewalk and the curb)

SECTION TWO: Limited Parking Permitted ONLY:

- a) Unforeseen family emergency/crisis
- b) Mayor may, upon reasonable notice, permit exception as requested by resident. The exception shall not exceed two (2) requests per year. Resident must obtain a permit from the City Clerk and permit must be prominently displaced in the vehicle's window.

SECTION THREE: The Chief of Police or any other person authorized by the Mayor and City Council shall cause signs to be posted in all areas where parking is limited or prohibited.

SECTION FOUR: Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a civil penalty as follows:

- a) 1st offense written warning;
- b) 2nd offense is a \$50.00 civil penalty;
- c) 3rd offense is a \$100.00 civil penalty and the vehicle will be removed at owner's expense.

SECTION FIVE: No parking upon any street shall be permitted when the national weather service has predicted snow and/or ice within the area of the City of Hunters Hollow.

SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

SECTION SEVEN: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION EIGHT: Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Given second reading, voted upon and passed at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 21st day of May, 2019.
